### **Purpose of Data Processing:**

We process your data for the mediation of potential orders corresponding to your qualification profile. The legal basis for this is Art. 6 para. 1 lit. b) DSGVO due to the implementation of pre-contractual measures and agreements of the cooperation agreement. A further legal basis results from Art. 6 para. 1 lit. a) DSGVO on the basis of your consent in the application process. You can revoke your consent at any time.

### **Categories of Recipients:**

Selected usd AG employees can access the data internally. Furthermore, after prior consultation with you, your data will be passed on to third parties (usually client companies) within the scope of submitting an offer.

### **Data Erasure:**

If no legal retention period exists, the data will be deleted as soon as storage is no longer necessary. In individual cases, individual data may be stored for a longer period of time. In these cases, the duration of the storage depends on the legal storage obligations, e.g. from the tax code (six years) or the commercial code (ten years).

Every data subject has the right to complain to a supervisory authority if he or she is of the opinion that the processing of the data concerning him or her violates data protection provisions (Art. 77 GDPR).
